And to confirm found ceramics under many. Mso while clearing found a soil color change from Dark Brown to yellowish.






Upon later inspection because it was only one course I believe there is a possibility mut it was tumble because it was administrating tocated a bit above my living surface clay. My second feature was Corry a busul wall consisting of 2 courses that were preserved. Corry went my tap Width of my trench and continued beyond. It looks good that it will match

"Larry" and "Mo." Preceeding up the building we were unable to find another wall or terrace. The only other naticable feature where two oddly placed rockstructures.

EUIT EUG

We surmissed that it was either a coincidence or it might have been post hole structures. It was more likely a Coincidence because It was completely surrounded by fill with No preseased prehibitorie to point to a terrace or wall.





8 July 2010 Excavation took place from June 30 2010 and Final notes were completed on 8 July 2010. For Sile 007 OP 10, Sub- OP 36 1815 1-32 I Nine | x | meter units were setup In an axial trench up the Wostern side of the mound (called structure 3). The French was oriented East-West and EUA was me western most unit. Its a special note. EUI much shared two points with sub-op 37. They shared the Southern points of EUI in my trench.


The first two units executed were EUA+B. They were both free of tumble and we Expressioner presumed that Isince we were not yet to the mound, we would not find prehitectual features yet. In EUA we went to sterile soil which was not that deep. We hit Sterile yellowish Brown clay at 996.89. We begun to find temble ix EUC. It was Flat layed and at first we thought it might be a beginning of a Moor. IN EUD We began to removed tumble to level with

We found a hoge deposit of Baja et 997, 107 that was concentrated at the southern wall but spread into half the Unit in 10/36/012. Fing down Further we began to hit the first or many tunnels rowerns. These honnels were caused by animals, and the writers, finding a cache of about a dozen already hatched eggs, pernanced the animal in question to be an Iguana. Further Down in EUD divectly below the Baja deposit we found another covern filled with carbon. 10/36/19. The humble that we are pulling out is very jumbled and oriented in many different ways



The carbon deposit was discoved when we removed dymbre that was can be described as vertical that rocks. However, we could not determine that it was a collapsed wall because we could not find the base of a wall and we continued to find turnste beneath. The I quana holes became increasingly troublesome and Collapses were begining to become common. The loosing packed sediment

and tumble made declaiphering very difficult, and busically impossible. We lest most at the fumble in EUE F because of time constraints and saffy harards. At the top of our mound in EUG we found what we believe to be the remnents of a column. This is the only preserved Ceature in my sub-op. The feature is rulled Caliban and it was 6-10 courses high and 2 courses wide



Caliban is classified as a column rather than a wall because of the fall pattern. The northern side is falling north as if there is not another course and the rocks all line op well and seem to end at the end of the wall. 10/36/28 we went down till we hit a gravely clay. Due to fine Constraints we were unable to get to the bottom of Caliban. Probire the surface we could determine that it has at least one more course. In EU I we found possible tumble from a wall, with the absence of any rock from (alban to the humble), we betieve that that indicates the presence of a room with the front of the building opening up with columns. The
