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Monday 15 June 2009

2009-17-01

Over the past few days (Friday → Monday) Ellen, Stephanie, & I have been preparing to start field work. On Friday we visited the locations where we would like to work this short season → S-009 north of Los Morangitos (S-007) and three small rural residential groups on the El Paraíso side of the river. The S-009 site is located on Don Ernesto's land who we worked w/ last year (Str 12; S-007) and the rural sites are located on Don Jorge España's land. Since once again this morning we were unable to find Jorge España, we headed out to Cafetal to shoot points over into Don Ernesto's field. It took S & I a good 20 min to set up the machine the 1<sup>st</sup> time. Instructions => plant feet / center over dot; move legs ↑↓ until bubble is in the CIRCLE; then fine tune w/ horiz. level. We shot to the top of Cafetal Str. 8 & then shot in 2 points → one near the east side of Str 12 (S-007) & one ≈ — m NE of Str 12, next to a smaller i.e. really low mound. This way we will not have to slog through the cafetal to shoot a back sight.

Santiago arrived while we were @ Cafetal. After discussing his options for excavation he preferred to do the solares testing prog. in the neighborhoods @ El Paraíso.

Monday 15 June 2009

Since Santiago's choice is to do the solars testing, I will now be finishing up work at Los Morangitos & investigating the smaller sites that form Site S-009.

A site that may abut the NE side of Str 12 (it is Str -) seems to have VERY well preserved lines & even some summit architecture. This is really exciting since to date we haven't really found summit arch-<sup>Los Morangitos</sup> except Str 9. This site may also shed light on the purpose of Str 12. I will first investigate this site then several of the smaller (low) mounds that form S-009. Then hopefully I can turn my attention to the north side of Str 12 which, hopefully, is well preserved like the South side & is only buried in tumble. There is a lot of tumble → to large irregular rocks which makes me wonder if they were part of the platform or if they formed some sort of summit architecture.

This afternoon once we gather permission from the landowners, we will probably shoot from El Paraiso to the rural sites. Provided E. gets the data collector to correctly communicate w/ the computer. This afternoon we set up a station on the top of Str 1 @ El P. in an effort to shoot over to the rural sites. Need Chema's (mayor) permission to put stakes under his H<sub>2</sub>O tower to make an easy jump to the new sites. Got permission from Don Ernesto - need to be careful of beans.

Tuesday June 2009

2009-17-003

This morning E, S & I arrived @ Los Narangitos (S-007) to get it set up for excavation. E made the executive decision to include what was formerly S-009 → the stns that form a patio NE of Str 12 as part of site S-007. The stns have been renumbered accordingly. I decided to set a N/E grid and layout the trenches according to that.

First we ~~had~~ laid out a <sup>Op 10 Subop 25</sup> 1 N x 9 E m trench over Str. 15. The trench is located approx. in the center N/S of the str. The goal is to uncover the arch which seems to be well preserved; including summit arch! There may be a slight problem w/ a tree stump on the summit. Next we laid out a 7(?) m E x 1 m N trench across STR 22. The purpose is to expose the architecture & learn more @ the smaller stns that are part of S-007.

Now, after lunch, workers are clearing ~~clean~~ chape from the mounds so that we can take photos that show lines etc.


We have now started excavations.

Lot # 1 EU A Op 10 Subop 25 is located on the E end of ~~St~~ Stn 25. Currently Don Dinas & Tino are excavating a 0.1 m lot to expose the stratigraphy. Lot # 2 EU I Op 10 Subop 25 is located on the W side of the trench. Fili & Verniges<sup>(?)</sup> are also excavating a 0.1 m lot.




Am starting Lot #12 EU D in order to expose the summit architecture of Str 15.

Lot # 1 EU <sup>A</sup> is south of EU C. It will uncover the front of the E. wall as it angles SW.



In lot # ~~204~~ EV D - found a nice large chunk of carbon on the W side of the wall about 8" from the base of the wall, near some bajareque & ceramics.

Have kind of come across a rock pile in both new EVs. I'm not sure that opening these EVs actually makes anything clearer. Removed some of the semi-flat (large) rock fall from EV E - the cobble surface seems to continue, so will use that as our base for architecture.

Found mano in EV E mixed in w/ the wall.  
\*Found another possible finger bone on the E side of the wall in EV E. It was at about the same level as the cobble surface which apparently is only  $\approx$  4 courses (2") wide - like a path. The cobble surface is on top of both bajareque frags & ceramics.

Jorge & Gisela are now going down on the S side of the surface to see if it is a wall, since the rocks on the S. side seem to be facing - flat faced south. Found another possible bajareque feature.

S of the C.S. in the middle of the EV. The bajareque layer - although not as concentrated as the 1<sup>st</sup> layer it extends out <sup>(S)</sup> from the cobble surface for  $\approx$  0.4m. It may even be the bajareque we are seeing in the wall/under the tumble in EV D. Am finding lots of large shards in EU E in the 'tumble'.





Since discovering that the wall makes a corner & goes east this means that the 2 little pieces of bone from the other morning from EU ~~E~~ were uncovered in fill like stuff near the corner of the wall & that the bone that looks like a finger bone from EU ~~A~~ <sup>C</sup> ~~18~~ ~~web~~ was found on/near the interior floor of the structure.







Ellen & I followed the following procedure w/ the vase. This was all documented through photographs & digital video.

The vase was extracted w/ the dirt still inside and was wrapped in several layers of foil. It was kept out of the sun for the remainder of the day (it was removed at 1pm). It was secured inside a cardboard box w/ balled up plastic bags and carefully transported via car to the lab. Since we had the proper equipment thanks to Jim, we were able to collect clean pollen samples which Ram might be able to test for us. We loosened the dirt using dental picks & then removed it using metal kitchen spoons. This was done in levels of several cm each. Pollen samples were taken at the following levels below the rim <sup>also</sup> ~~as well~~ all the soil from the bottom of the vase ~~was~~ was collected. It appears that the vase was empty when the rim started to chip/crack, since small pieces of rim are found from 8cm down including a large piece on the bottom. These pieces were collected in a separate ~~the~~ whirl pack bag. The pollen samples were collected in sealed whirl pack bags & the tools were cleaned w/ kimwipes before each sample was taken.



Am starting new lot to clear down after removing other offering crypt capstones. This will be lot # 10 EU's A & C. Found <sup>several</sup> parts of metates → one is really well used. One was used as a capstone & another was in the hole ≈ the same level as the base it is an interesting juxtaposition. Will continue down to level of yellow clay → so far only random sherds & metate frags have been found. Have found 4 diff. pieces of metate, ~~one~~ one was under back of a rock ~~that~~ makes up the wall. Another was stuck almost vertically in the center of the crypt.
