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Over the past few days (Friday > Monday) Start field work. On feiday we visited the locations where we would like to work this short season -> S-009 worth of Los Manaujitos (S-007) and three small rural residential groups on the El Paratso side of the river. The S-009 site is located on Don Ernesto's Land who we worked w/last year (Stre 12; S-007) and the rural sites are located on Don Jorge España's land. Since once again this Morning we were unable to find Jorge Eparia, we headed out to Cafetal to shoot points over into Don Ernestos field. It to S& I a good ZO min to ser up the machine the 1st time. Instructions => plant feet / center over dot; move legs It until bubble is in the CIRCLE; then fine toone w/ hoving. We shot to the top of Cafetail Stre. 8 \$ then shot in 2 points -> one near the east side of Str 12 (5-007) & one = m NE of Str 12, next to a smaller ic. really low. mound. This way we will not have to slog through the cafetal to shoot a back sitght.

Santiago arrived while we were @ Cafulal. After discussing his options for exeavation he preferred to do the solares testing prog. in the neighborhoods or El Paraiso.

Shee Santiago's choice is to do the solares testing, I will now be finishing up work at Los Monanjitos \$ investigating the smaller stres that form site 5-009. A ste that may about the NE side of Stre 12 (it is Stre _) seems to have very well preserved lines \$ even some summit architecture. This is found summit auch - except Ste 9. This ste may also shed light on the purpose of Str12. I will first investigate this stre then several of the smaller (low) mounds that form 5-009. Then hopefully I can turn my attention to the North side of Str. 12 which, hopefully, is swell preserved like the South side & is only buried in tumble. There is a lot of tumble -> tollarge irregular rocks which makes me wonder if they were part of the platform or if they formed some sort of summit architecture.

This afternoon once we gather permission from the landowners, We will probably shoot from El Paraiso to the rural sites. Provided E. gets the duta collector to correctly communicate with computer. This afternoon we set up a station on the top of Str I @ El P. in an effort to shoot over to the rural sites. Need Chema's (mayor) permission to put stakes under his H2O tower to make an easy jump to the new sites. Got permission from Don Erresto-need to be careful of sites. This morning E, S & arrived @ los Navaryitos (5-007) to get it set up for excavation. C'made the executive decision to include what was formerly S-009 → the stes that your a patrio NE of Ste 12 as part of site S-007. The stes have been renumbered accordingly. I decided to set a N/E grid and layout the trends according to that.
First we take laid out at IN × 9Em trench over Str. 15. The trench is located approx. in the center N/S of the 8tr. The goal is to uncover the auch which seems to be well preserved; including summit auch! There may be a slight peoblem w/ atree stump on the summit. Next we laid out a 7(?) m E x Im N trench across str 22. The purpose is to expose the architecture & learn more & the smaller stres that are part of 5-007.


Now, after lunch, workers are clearing com chafe from the mounds so that we can take photos that show lines etc.


We have now started excavations.

The vase was extracted w/ the dirt still inside and was wrapped in several layers of Joil. It was kept out of the sun for the remainder of the day (it was removed at Ipm). It was secured inside a condboard box w balled up plastic bags and carefully transported via can to the lab. Since we had the proper equipment thanks to Jim, we were able to collect clean pollen samples which Ram might be able to test for us. We loosened The dirt using deutal picks & then removed it using metal kitchen spoons. This was done in levels of several Levels bellow the rim were taken at the following soil from the bottom of the vase see was collected. It appears that the vase was empty when the Rim started to chip/crack, since small pieces of Rim au found from Sem down including a large piece on the bottom. This pieces were collected in a separate ster Puhir I pack bag. The pollen samples were collected in sealed whiel pack bage 4 the tools were cleaned w/ kimwkips before each sample was taken.


