Went in search of households which were behind ste 3/4(2), the long/low stre to the coffee to explore alone. Next attempted to 5 June 2005 Mary Hostevske POS-17-01 on the w side of the plata & too much coffee to explore alone. Next attempted to visit Cl Guayabal, but couldn't get through. So drove to Las Aquidias Interesting site. Makes me wonder if the normal citizens built up earther platforms to live on, to go w/ the earthern Str. and if so would they be visible?
