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

Toba was photo graphed and measured as well as plotted with the EDM. The most prominent sculpture was scroll like Front Bots and pressure into to pices that fit together. It was found together in situ. A ceramic vessel was found in the Northern Wall unde a Toba block, on the stuce floor. This is perhaps one of the only primary deposits we have.
