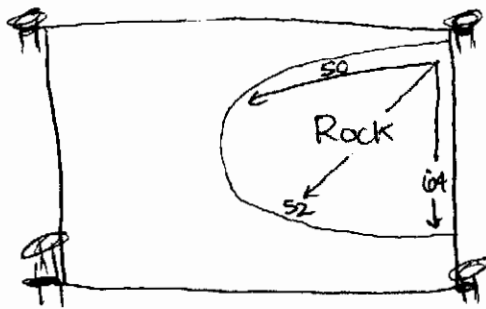

Since we think the floor may be on this level we've decided to expand into a second excavation unit (EU B) so we can obtain a better view of the general floor (if it exists). We left this lot open @ 51cm BGS (@ highest pt.) and moved one meter south to EU B. Upon returning to this lot, we notice that the east side of the lg. rock is remarkably flat, indicating that the rock may have fallen over from the adjacent (eastern) units. No artifacts found in this lot.
