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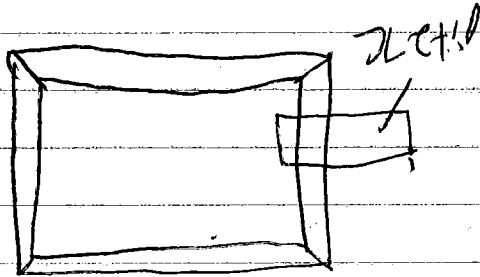
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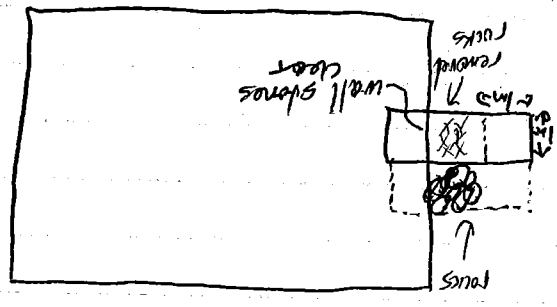
Searching for structure + shards for writing

We began digging this pit with a 1x1m square in the westernmost portion. After 40cm and 4 lots, a bedrock - we think - layer was hit. So we began extending the pit eastward, toward the wall. Due to a misunderstanding of the instructions, the workers removed several rocks on the way to the west wall. We were forced then to expand the pit to the north and see what it was that the workers removed.



Most of the rocks, it seems, fell from the top of the structure and were not part of the wall itself. They are on angles and without order. In general, there have been scores (so far 7 shards and 27 jets). It might therefore be difficult for us to date the mound. If little more is found today, we may abandon this site and head for more fertile ground. We are trying to excavate into the wall, so that we can hit it head-on. Otherwise, we may not know for sure if we did run into a wall.

Arifacts from this pit, and the mound in general have been scores (so far 7 shards and 27 jets). It might therefore be difficult for us to date the mound. If little more is found today, we may abandon this site and head for more fertile ground. We are trying to excavate into the wall, so that we can hit it head-on. Otherwise, we may not know for sure if we did run into a wall.

Still no artifacts found here.

was found. Pat decided then to

20cm deep lots. After the first 20cm,

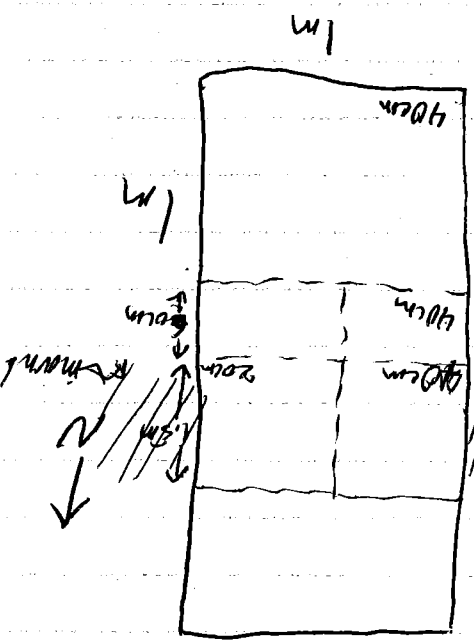

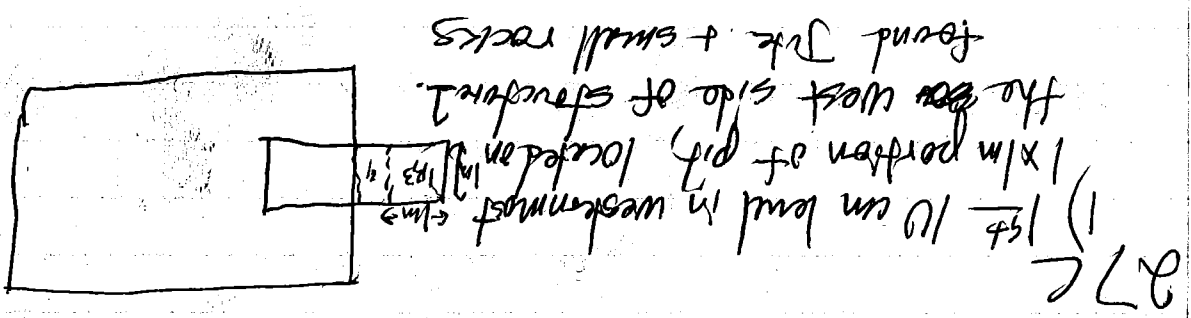
Soil sampling, cont

Jill and Alex took several other samples from the back of the mound. If one area shows a high phosphorus concentration, we will excavate it. The rear side of the mound was divided into 4 equal 5m regions, designated W, U, G, and E. Four sample cores were taken from each sample area. The easternmost was the only exception, with six cores.

Right now we are one shovel short, so there are three working on 25H, which is silly, so after a shelter is built, I am going to send one down for another shovel. If I can get that access taken.

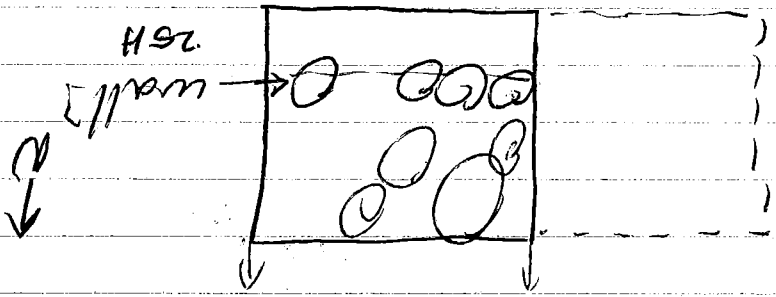

Real when I get back, a wall uncovered. It is about 20 cm down. North extension comes down right on top of it. Few boards, however, found in area. Expanding pt east - away from pole - to search for corner.

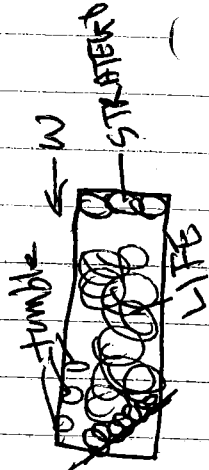

STRATERO - a wall or possibly a step up ft another wall in str C, which is probably S-sided.

Pit uncovered a cobbleson pavement (see D44-15-8) running away from STRATERO. Pavement Name: LIFE.

Three soil layers found in pit - a loose compacted, brown, fine soil on top of a greaser, clayey, compact variety with about the same color.

STRATERO is not // or L to MASTERPIECE, so str C is probably S-sided. Further mapping should make this point more clear.



250 did not produce many shreds, except near some tumble on the north wall in the western 1.5m of pit. One interesting piece that appears as a <sup>shy</sup> pattern/sidways handle. This may be due to modern infirmation, as a brick was also found in this pit. LIFE makes a slight angle at 2920 off into ~~the~~ north wall of pit. See diagram to left.
