

# Lab Notes Concerning 1983 Season

Lots 10D/9 and 10D/10 were unwashed as of the end of the season. They may have gotten mixed up. Lot 10D/9 should contain obsidion and Lot 10D/10 should contain quartzite.

There was some confusion with lots 10G/48 and 10G/47 and with their lot cards, they may or may not exist

After hot Card 2A/10 there is a jump to 2A/100 then to 2A/10 cand then to 2A/120. This is because Mark arbitratily these three numbers without checking with Kathleen.

Drigional Cards that have been duplicated should have a star (x1) in the upper left hand corner to indicate this,

About half way through the 1983 season we started putting subtatals after the descriptions of items on the back of lot cards to indicate that there was more than one bag of things.

· Partway through the season we stopped numbering allor the shorts in the lots due to lacks of time and man power.

# Lab Notes Concerning 1984 Season

The material called Black Rock Type A has been identified as Andesite and will now start appearing under Shat name. But past records will be left with the designation of Black Rock Type A (BRTA).

The hab has created OPE2C Ho help deal with lot tags that were severly damaged and partially unreadable due to storage in the Copan bodga during the OFF season.

Jute are not being washed and cleaned out of dirt as completely as last year. They are still being counted and weighed. After the weight we are putting the notation up to indicate that they are unwashed and that the dirt content may skew the weight corolations to better washed lots.

This year our three sherd washers also did alot of the work of numbering and counting the sherds and recording the counts on the lot cards. As a result the "brief descriptions" have occasionally been mispelled is "tilandesite for ambesite or put in Spanish "obsidiona". We have tried to correct this when it was encountered but that didn't always happen. Also for awhile one of them was numbering things with dashs rather then slashs (in 6A-2 us 6A/2) again I have tried to correct these. Also many of the sherds got numbered on the rim across the center or over part of the design.

In bagging and counting lots 6A/28, 6A/30, +6A/33 I noticed that some of the jute were noticeably larger than the average jute and also that many of them had unbroken tips. This might be worth looking at further at a later time. It might also pay to look at lots related to these and see it they have similar jute.

# Lab Notes Concerning 1984 Season Cont.

Flotation contents are being recorded on the Lot carels an F is being but after the lot number to indicate that it is from flotation as opposed to the normal pit contents. (This was also done in 1983).

At different times during the season depending on the pressures of time we numbered = either all of the sherds or only the rims, apendages and other diagnostic or distinctive sherds

Lot 26 F/1 may be incorrectly numbered there was a mix up of tags in washing it could possibly be 260/16

In booking through the lot cards we found some 1983 lot cards that seem to be missing. It is possible that they were misplaced during the interveneing year at some point an exfort should be made to locate them or an eye be kept open for them. They are Numbers 547, 5421, 5H/23-30+Dup.

Lots 52B/1-6 was revorsed with 52D/1-6. These pits, 52B and 52D were revorsed when there was a change in people working at the site. Lots 52B/1-6 were subsequently changed to 52D/1-6 and vice verser when the mistake was discovered.
