Santo Domingo Cave, Burial #1, Observer #9, 16 July 2002

These bones are from Burial #1 at Santo Domingo Cave (the "Basket Burial"). The rest of the burial was left in situ in the cave. The bones present are extremely fragmentary, though most of them appear to fit together, and are from the same bone. I believe the bone is a fragment of a tibia, but it can't be sided. There are also a few very small fragments that seem to be from a different bone, but they are too small to identify which bone they came from.
