This individual is represented by a lower right 2nd molar. The enamel is worn nearly to the dentin, and is chipped off on most of the lingual side, as well as off of the mesial interproximal and most of the buccal ~~area~~ surfaces. There are no visible caries. A small amount of calculus is present on the distal interproximal surface, just above the root.
