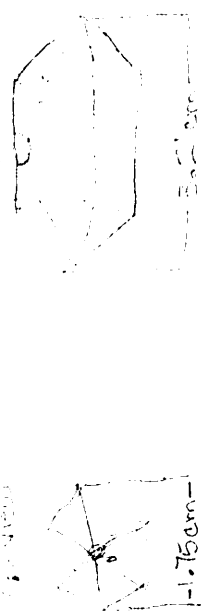
SUBSTANCE: Quartz?

PSB 2B/13-1	<p>A hexagonal clear rock crystal possibly of quartz. It is not totally transparent but rather a little cloudy on the inside. The center part of the crystal has six oblong faces of equal lengths but varying or irregular widths, (length = 1.82cm widths 1cm to 0.77cm). These faces have visible natural lines on them going widthwise. Most of these faces are smooth but two of them have small protruding irregularities, in one of these cases the protrusion is almost worn away. Both ends of the crystal come to the shape of six sided pyramids formed by the joining of six triangular faces. These vary in size depending on the size of the central face they adjoin. The tips of these pyramids are blunted from wear. The various edges between the sides tends while not sharp are well defined and clear both to sight + touch. The crystal is also smooth to the touch.</p>	6
