| PSB 106 Z/10-1 | <p>Appears to be a complete mano (breakage at one end could disguise extension). The stone is dirt-brown with many small to mid-size (up to 8x8mm) inclusions, and is shaped like a short loaf of bread. Grinding surface is flat and somewhat smooth. Top (opposite grinding surface) and both sides of mano are battered, with 2 chunk-like holes on the top and 1 long, flat breakage on each side, scattered small pores throughout rock.
