PSB/F/136-1	<p>A modeled censer fragment. Impossible to tell exact part of censer it is from. There is a protrusion in the middle of the fragment.</p> <p>(10YR6/3) is its color. There are three lines running across the protrusion and down one of the sides. On that side is also an indentation, the fragment is 2.23cm thick at its thickest point. The rest of the sherd is 3.37m x 3.61cm.</p> <p>The texture is coarse and the paste large. No rim is visible.</p>	Alt
