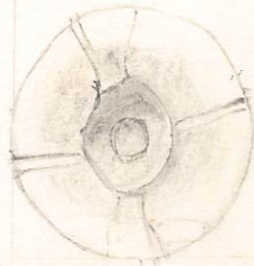

PSB 3A/7-1	<p>candelero fragment. This candelero fragment is a well-made flat bottomed cylindrical shape. The piece is incomplete but broken along all four air holes, a rather regular break looking into the hole of the candelero, one notices a round projection of clay. This probably resulted from making the hole with a hollow tube of some sort which forced some of the clay up into the tube. The projection was approx. 0.16 cm above the bottom of the hole. At the deepest point the hole is 1.94 cm. deep. The inner color and much of the inner paste is masked by burning but the visible inner paste is 7.5/R 6/4, light brown. The outer surface is 7.5/R 6.5/4 light brown/pink.</p>	AEC	AEC
