

rimolium	This is a fragment of a scored conser lid. w/ part of the Tim edge attached. The paste is medium to medium coarse w/a fair number of small to medium white, black+pink inclusions. The non scored side of the shered has been smoothed, Smoothing marks are visible. The scored side also looks to have been smoothed befare it was scored. The scoring is neither deep nor wide. I twas probably made by a single pointed instrument. The linese run on opposite diagonals forming rectangles of irregular sizes.
