PSB3E/10-1	<p>This is a fragment of a scored censer lid. The paste is not especially coarse but does have a number of visible inclusions white, mica + red. Most are fairly small but a few are small pebble size. The non scored side of the sherd has been smoothed but not finished in any other way. The scored side was also smoothed and seems to have been scored while the clay was still at least partly wet. The scoring seems to have been done with a single pointed instrument. The scoring varies in depth. The lines run, both horizontally and vertically creating rectangular or trapezoidal areas of irregular size. The scored side is buried black from use (probably). The horizontal incision was done first, then the vertical.</p> <p>Thickness</p> <p>min - 0.68 cm</p> <p>max 1.19 cm</p>	6	6

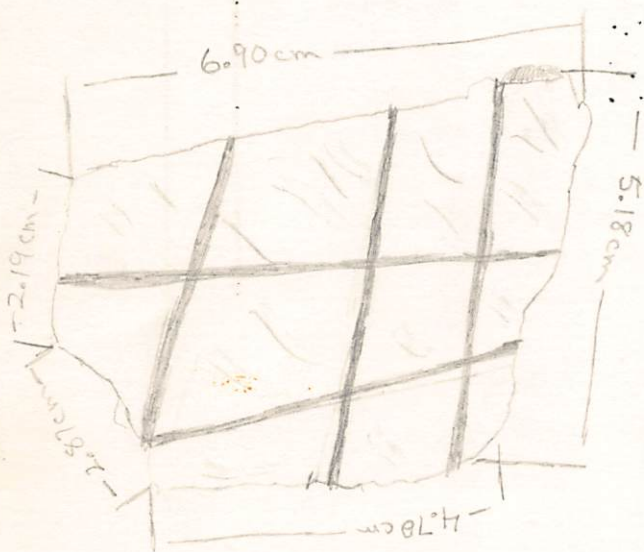
