This is a fragment of a spiked ceramic. The paste is medium in texture w/ a number of small to medium sized visible white inclusions. There are also a couple of pebble sized visible red inclusions. The paste is slightly soft and brownish in color. The surfaces are black probably from being buried in use. The non spiked side of the fragment has been smoothed and shows smoothing marks. The spiked side was also fairly well smoothed. The spike itself is also smooth and looks to have been applied to rather than pulled up out of the shard. The spike is slightly worn and blunted. The shard curves slightly
