

NUMBER FULL DESC: PTION PSB 3E/10-3 A Candelero Fragment with 2 long thin chambers. 31 It appears that this fragment is the bottom of a candelero because the bases of both chambers are visible. The bottom of the dividing area, and the chambers are burnt blact. There are # partial pierced holes along the sides of each chamber. - These are airholes which go all theway through the walls The paste has many medium-sized white 1 black inclusions. The white inclusions are visible throughout entire fragment.

COLOUR - 104R 5/1 Grey

Note: air holes go all the way through
