PSB 3E/10-3	<p>A Candelero Fragment with 2 long thin chambers. It appears that this fragment is the bottom of a candelero because the bases of both chambers are visible. The bottom of the dividing area, and the chambers are burnt black. There are # partial pierced holes along the sides of each chamber. — These are airholes which go all the way through the walls. The paste has many medium-sized white &amp; black inclusions. The white inclusions are visible throughout entire fragment.</p>	31
