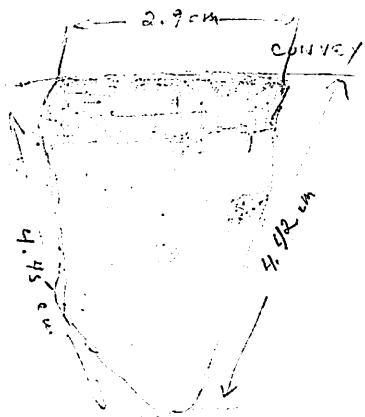

<p>3E/26-2</p> <p>THICKNESS: 0.7cm</p>	<p>Remnants of 2 holes along the fractures and an entire piercing on concave side that does not go through to the convex side.</p> <p>The rim is painted red and reaches down about 1cm on either side. The concave side is burnt black from use. Above the piercing is a scoring mark that appears intentional and there are no holes or remnants above this - it could be coincidence or intentional.</p> <p>Paste is very fine with a few small inclusions white and shiny ones. No firing core.</p>	<p>38</p>	<p>Colours</p> <p>Paste: 7.5YR 5/6 Strong brown</p> <p>Paint for <sup>4/8</sup> Red</p> <p>Concave <sup>7.5YR 6/4</sup> and <del>Light brown</del> <sup>7.5YR 3/6</sup> Light brown + very dark grey</p> <p>Convex <sup>7.5YR 6/4</sup> <del>Light brown</del> Light brown</p>
