PSB 35-37-1

Medium fine paste with slightly ^(Fine) sandy inclusions. There is no firing core however there is a slip on both sides of the frag. Using the ever handy Munsell color charts the frag appears to be color 5YR 5/4 known to most as reddish brown. The surface is smooth on the backside and looks burned in some areas. On the top the frag is scored with a cross hatch pattern w/ no real definite square size. although I would venture to say ~~it is~~ on average of 2.5cm by 2.5cm. The insisions are about 2mm wide and 2mm deep. There is slip on both sides.

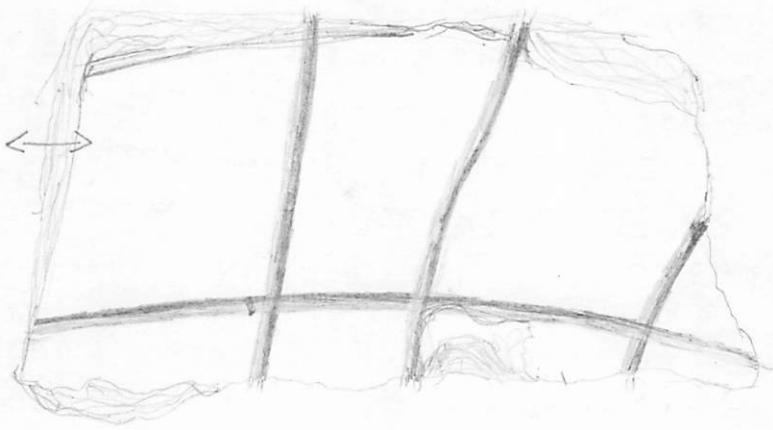
