<i>PSB 34/3-2</i>	<p><i>rectangular in shape. Fine paste, orange pink color w/ specks of white, black and silver. The sides w/ the largest surface - the front &amp; fragment and back fragment - are fair, well worn. The front side is smoother than the back. The back side is rather grainy in texture - sand paperish. Given that these surfaces lay on the frontal plane - the edges that lie on the transverse plane are rounded and smooth and well-worn. Edges that lie along the sagittal plane indicate clear breaks - one side is a relatively straight break - the other is somewhat diagonal. The firing one is not clear evident. There seems to be a light sandy colored one that underlies outer surface of the ceramic. Outer covering around this is about 1 cm thick. Throughout core there are white &amp; black specks.</i></p> <p><i>Width - 2.8 cm (distance between edges on transverse plane)</i>  <i>Length - 5.8 cm.</i>  <i>Thickness - 1.6 cm</i>  <i>Color - 5YR 6/4 - light reddish brown.</i></p>	36
