This is part of a double loop strap handle with part of the loop intact! It is not on the normal ~~double~~ double loop paste though this paste is fire w/ few inclusions, hard and brown. (a bit like a fine mesic?) It is also unusual because it is painted. The top of the handle is painted w/a red design on a roughly smoothed surface. It was then slightly burnished over the paint slightly smearing the paint + creating a slight self slip. Where the handle loops round it is solid red. The edges are also solid red.

The under side is roughly smoothed, but un painted, no evidence of double loop supports

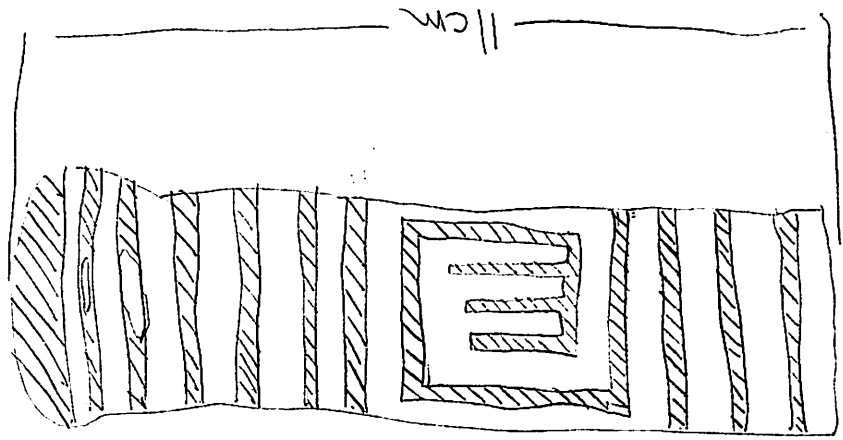
