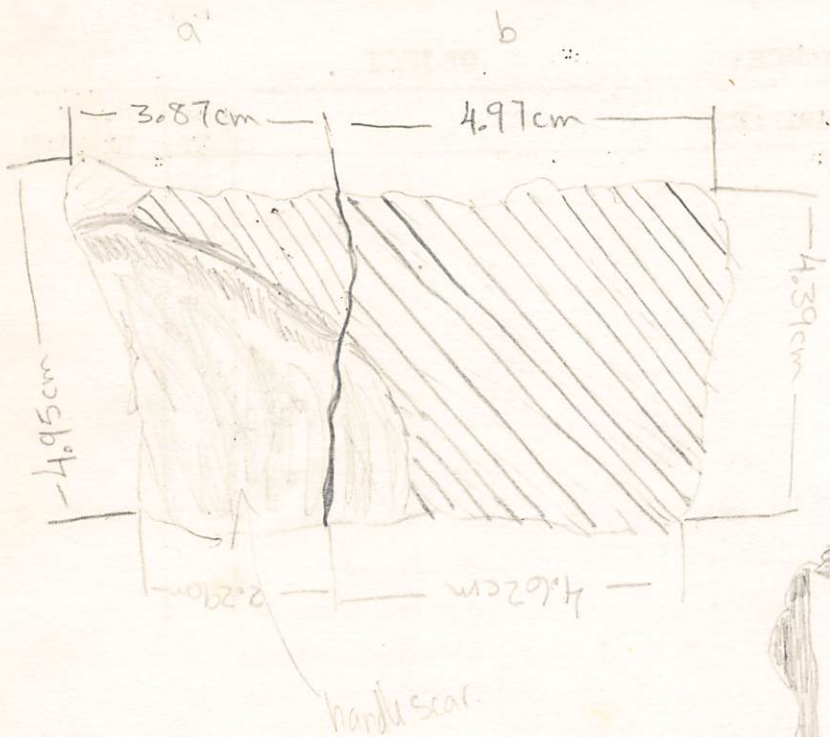

PSB 3M/1-2atb (May be related to) (3M/1-3.) between incision 1cm - 2.3cm incision width 1cm depth 0.5cm - 0.7cm	These are two fragments of a scored censer lid. The two pieces fit having broke right down the middle of one of the incisions. The paste is of medium ^{coars-} texture with numerous small + medium inclusions of white black + pink. The non scored side is somewhat indifferently smoothed. It also has an ^{light} orange slip or wash. There is also part of a large handle scar on this side. The scored side is also indifferently smoothed. The incision is quite wide, deep + crude seeming. It was either made we a wide blunt instrument or looks like it could have been made by impressing lengths of stick or reed into the wet clay. The incision runs in intersecting horizontal + vertical lines. The scored side + much of the paste is burnt Thickness. 1.25cm	6
