The incisions run parallel to each other (3 and 3) marking the shord face off into rectangular (roughty) quadrants The incisions where made with some sort of fasceted Hood this makes little grooves in the incision and mates are side of the incision steeper then the other. most of the grooves are on this steeper side. Next to one of the length wise incisions othere is a deep gouge about on inchilong. This causes the rearby incision to bend off its straight path.
