PSB 5 k / 9-1	<p>Scored Censor lid frag. edge with typical cross-hatch incisions. There is no firing core but the frag. is burnt all the way through. There are a few inclusions about 1mm in size &amp; even a few sparkly ones. According to the munsell color chart this frag is 10YR 6/3 known to the rest of the world simply as pale brown. The burnt area is 10YR 3/1 or very dark grey. The squares created by the cross hatch design measure <del>1mm</del> <del>wide</del> &amp; approx 1mm an average of 7mm by 6mm. The incisions are about 1mm deep &amp; 1mm wide. There is no paint or slip. However the piece is badly burnt from use. This frag is an edge of the censor lid unlike some who are just on the edge.</p>	35

The dimensions of the heart rate sensor lid are: 5.1 cm in length, 3.2 cm in width, & 1.15 cm thick. The paste is a fine paste.
