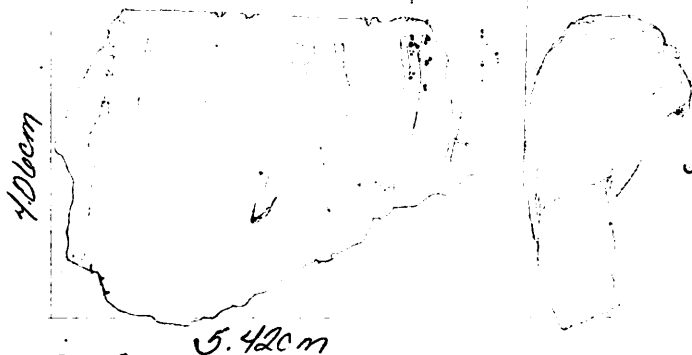

Censer fragment - a. Censer fragment which curves slightly to form the beginning of another face. The ~~the~~ main exterior surface is somewhat smooth and has eight incision lines on it. The lines are very shallow and about an inch long. They run straight, though a couple slant slightly. On the flat surface where the fragment curves there is an incised line running the length of the fragment in two places it is crossed by cross hatches (#-#) These incisions are a little deeper and rougher than those on the front.
