one side of fragment appears to have remainder of tubular type handle. There is a curving away from the original edge felt in the handle.

Other side has burnt surface, scored to original edge which looks more like a rim than another scored section. Next to edge is a section where the scoring has fallen off, leaving the possibility that the scores were applied. The lid is fairly flat on the whole.

Paste is a grainy medium fine orange with many small inclusions, white. Large firing core.

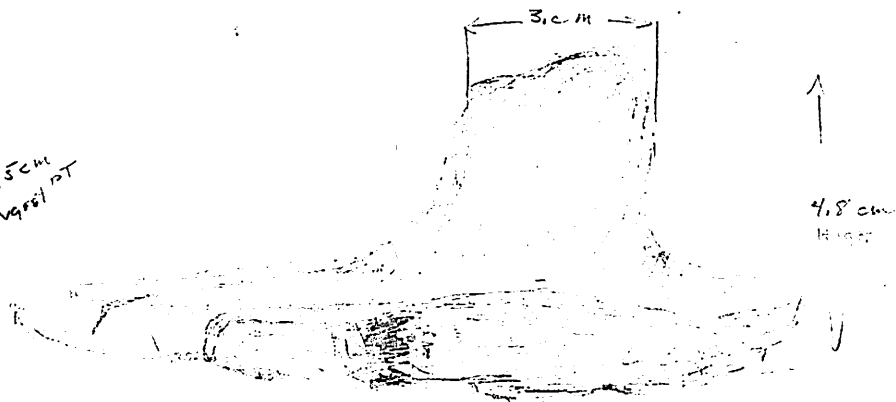
