A coarse pate with small sandy inclusions. There is a firm core which takes up most of the width of the fragment. Munsell

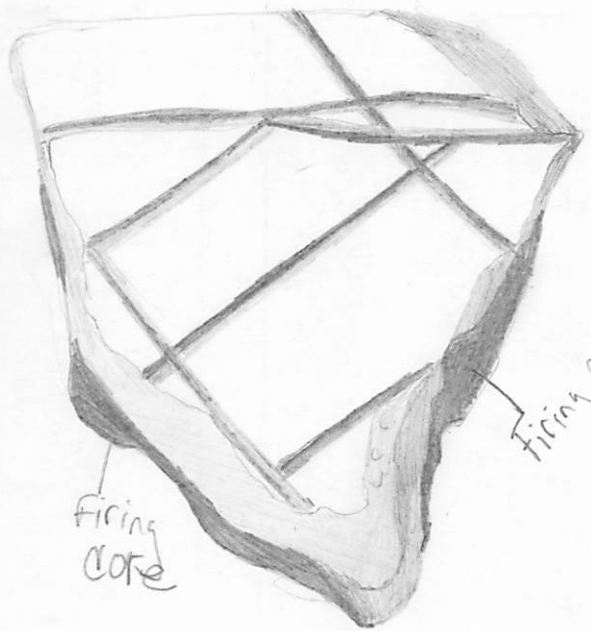
color of the smooth side is 10 YR 5/2 or grayish brown, the burnt scored side is ~~10 YR~~ 10 YR 3/1 or very dark gray. The core is 10 YR 2/1 or black. There is cross-hatch design on one side (the least side), the inclusions are about 2mm wide and about a 1mm deep.

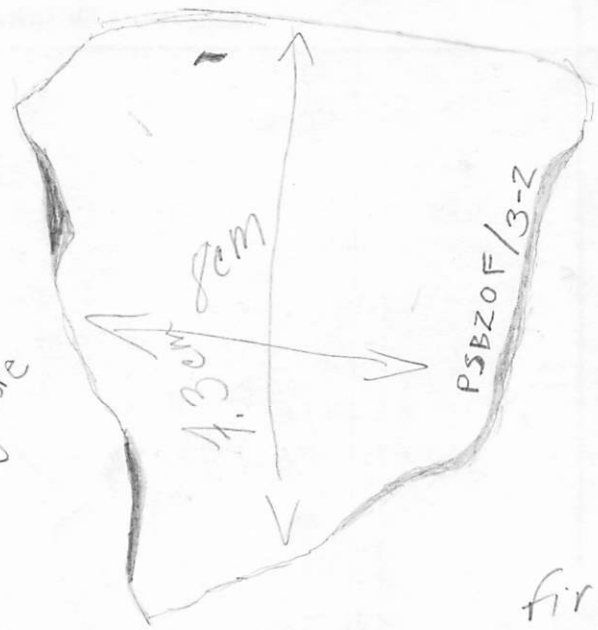
