PSB26D/15-2	<p>A crude and very ugly <del>condebero</del> condebero fragment. The clay is sandy to the touch and the distinguishing mark of the fragment is a finger-sized hole in one end. The clay around this end is much denser (7.54x40) than the rest of the fragment. <sup>(7.54x64)</sup> It is 3.58 cm by 4.37 cm. The fragment is 2.55 cm deep. The lip surrounding the indentation is 1.50 cm on the average. General uneven scars and patterns are visible on the underside.</p>	NH
