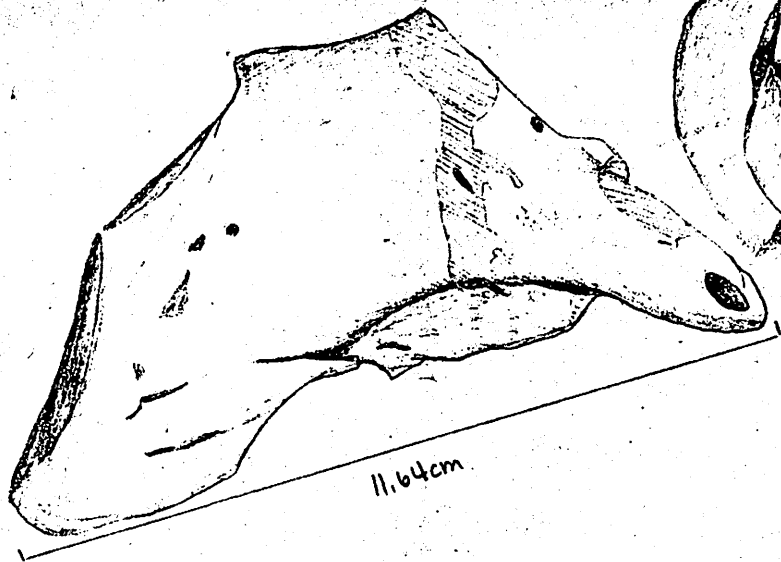

| PSB26D/16-8 | <p>This is a fragment of a mottled censer with red paint (2.5YR 3.5/6). The paste itself is 7.5YR 5.5/4. It is made of a coarse paste, sandy to touch with no visible inclusions. The fragment itself seems to be from an arm of the censer as it is curled and twisted much like a human arm and wrist. From the end of this fragment protrudes what seems to resemble a thumb with the indentation of a claw or nail at the end. The base of the hand is scarred from where it was broken from its support. Its dimensions are: length = 11.64cm; width = 4.16 cm; thickness = 0.72cm</p> | CS | |

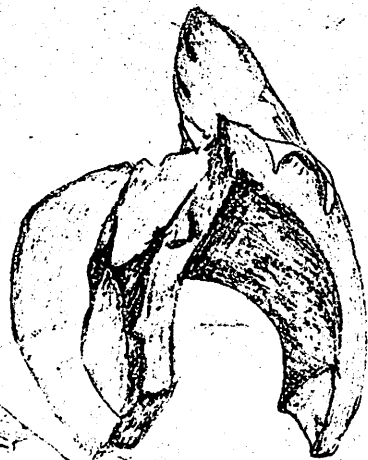
