NUMBER BY NUMBER this is a fragment of a mottled censer with red paint (251R) cs PSB26D/16-8 3.5/6). The paste itself is 7.5 XR 5.5/4 It is made of a coarse paste, souly to touch with no visible inclusions. The fragment itself seems to be from an arm of the censer as it is curled and twisted much like a human lower arm and wrist from the end of this fragment protrudes what seems to resemble a thumb with the indentation of a claw or new at the end. The base of the hand is scarred from where it was broken from its support. Its dimensions are: Length= 11.64cm; width= 4.16cm; thickness=0.72cm drawing on opposite side OBJECT CATALOG CARD
