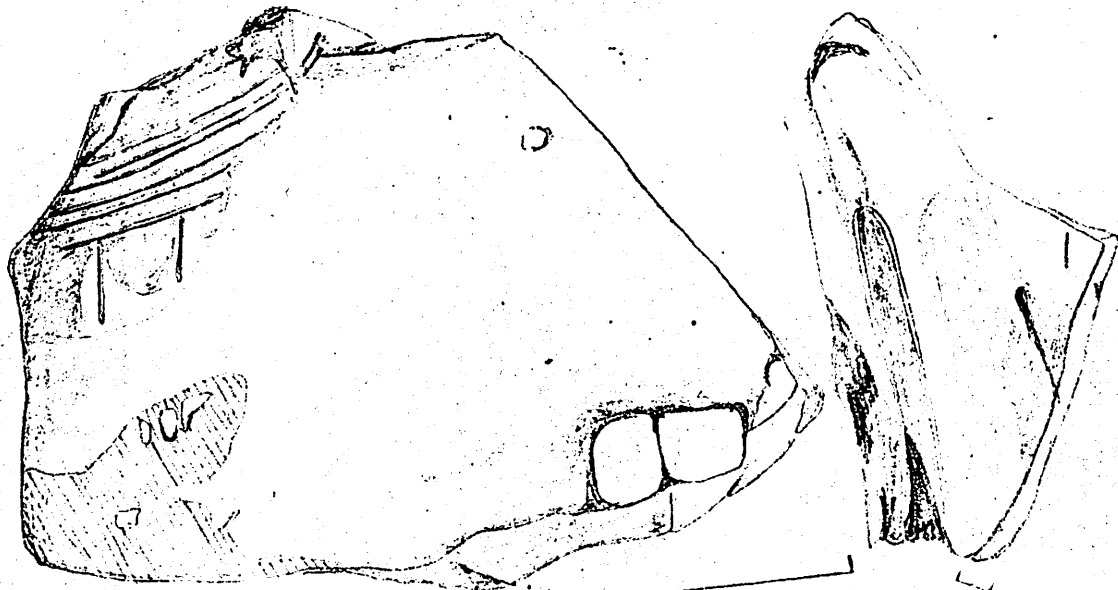

This censer fragment is decorated with incision and dark coloring (5YR4/1) and 2 small oblique bands. On the back of the fragment it seems that there were 2 chambers - one large and one small. The wall between them remains. As well on the front is red paint (2.5 YR 3.5/6) and burnished clay (5YR 6/4). The back is darkened perhaps by burning (5YR 4.5/1). Its dimensions are: length = 10.58 cm; width = 8.14 cm; thickness = 0.72 cm.
