PSB26E/9-1	<p>A stamp fragment made of coarse-grained clay. Most of stamp is complete. Stamp shaped like a clover <del>with</del> or flower with four leaves and a hole in the middle. Indentations follow each of the leaves. The leaves are on average of 1.96 cm wide and jut out from base 2.90 cm. The diameter from leaf to leaf is 5.13 cm. The hole in the middle has a diameter of 1.15 cm. The stamp is 1.23 cm thick. Its color is 5YR5/4.</p>	AH
