Penetration in slope - analyzing straight edges except for one edge. The largest surface - the upper surface under the plate, the stop handle is very smooth and free from. There are ridges and a slight protrusion throughout the fragment. On the surface is a slight in color then the upper surface - which is gray. Given that these surfaces are on the transverse plane - pointed plane - the edges that lie on the transverse plane are smooth and finished. The edges on the sagittal plane indicate bevels and reveal the firing one - which is a medium gray color - the grain surface is approximately 1.5 cm in width. The one itself seems to be about 6 cm. thick. One of these bevel edges is well worn and very straight. The opposite edge is somewhat diagonal in its break and is clipped on the upper surface

Width - 3.1 (the distance between the edges on transverse plane)

Length - 5.4 cm.

Thickness - 1.1 cm.

Color - 7.5 yr. 6/4 - light brown.
