NUMBER FULL DESCRIPTION CAT PHOTO/DWC NUMBER PSB 1060/18-4a,b 2 fragments of a candelero which fit together. 31 One narrow chamber is clearly visible - although only 1/2 remain. There remains a small portion of a curve of another chamber. There is also the remains of a "divider" which is clay (0.4cm thick) extending between the 2 chambers. The outside surface of the fragments are marked with 3 light score marks, I horizontal, 2 vertical. There are also a series of small gouges (4 pairs of COLOUR-The paste shows no large inclusions-appears quite uniform. The inside of the fragment is darker Outside 7.54R 7/4 Inside & Paste than the outside. 104R4/2
