NUMBER PSB 106C/20-5 This is probably part of a spiked censer from Which the spike's are missing. There are however five round scars on the shord face that could once have been spives. This same face of the Shord also contains remnents of red points. The paste is medium fine w/alarge dark fining core and numerous visible small white inclusions. The nonspixed face of the sherd is very indifferently smoothed an abit bumpy. The spiked face bears Smoothing marks (mabbe very shallow incision?). The Spikes were applied not pulled out of the surface as evidenced by the scars. color-Thickness! Paste: 10xR8/1.5 white verypale brown Min 1.06 cm Paint: 5YR 7/8 reddish yellow Max 1,35 cm
