PSB106C/34-3	<p>This is a fragment of a pierced censer. The paste is fairly fine but w/ some small white inclusions in it. Part of the sherd interior is burnt. There are four portions of 5 holes on the sherd. These were made with some sort of round implement which may have been hollow (this is suggested by an impression of up pushed clay at the bottom edge of one of the holes).</p> <p>Thickness: 0.51cm.</p> <p>Color: paste: 5YR 4.5/6 yellowish red.
