<p>PSB 106C/34-6</p> <p>Incision width 0.4cm depth 0.2cm dist. between 1.0-2.3cm</p>	<p>This is a fragment of scored censer lid. The paste is med. coarse with lots of inclusions of white, brown, black, shiny and some red. Ranging in size from small to small pebbles. There is a three color layering in the paste. Near the nonscored side it is yellow brown in color, then there is a black firing core, and near the scored surface it is more a chocolate brown.</p> <p>The nonscored side is well smoothed and has two small spots of red paint on it. The scored side has also been smoothed before being scored. The scoring is wide but not too deep. It was made while the clay was wet. The lines go both horizontally and vertically creating square and rectangular spaces of irregular sizes. The scored surface is burnt</p>	<p>6</p>	<p>6</p>
