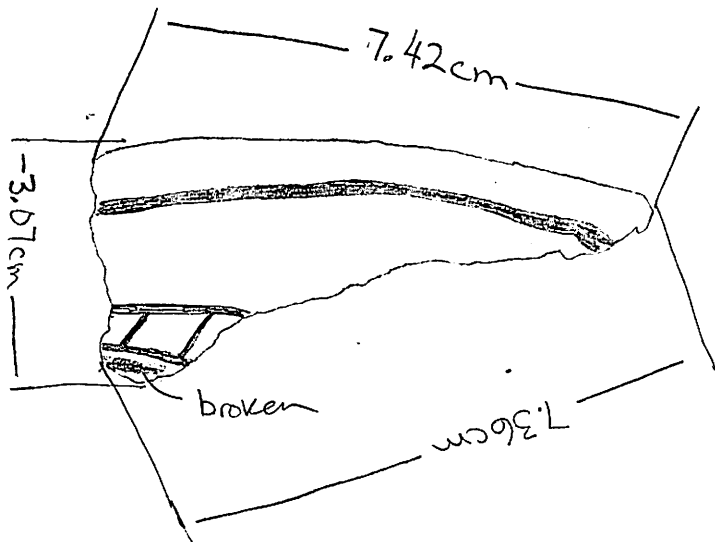

PSB 106C/34-7	<p>This is a rim fragment of a scored censer lid.</p> <p>The rim is thick + roughly rounded. The paste is crude w/ a number of small to large inclusions of white, shiny, red and black. It has a black firing core of about 1/3 the sherds thickness. The non-sc scored side has been well smoothed. The sc scored side is not as well smoothed. The incision is not terribly deep and is fairly narrow. One line runs parallel to the rim the other incision is mostly broken off but looks like it might have been the typical rectangular spaces design. The scored surface is burnt.</p> <p>Incision was made w/ a single pointed instrument.</p> <p>Thickness: 1.51cm</p>	6	6
