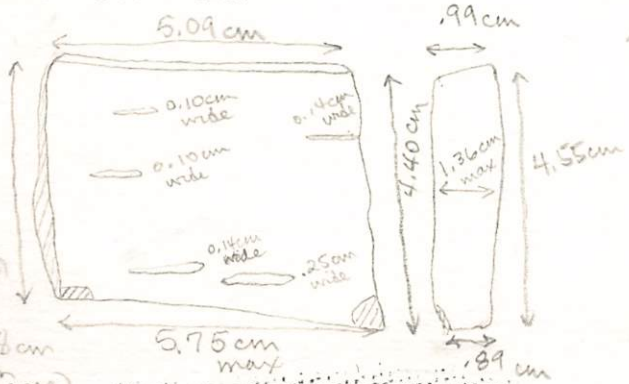

PSB 106 F/14 - 1

Fragment of broad strap handle for censer moderately coarse orange paste (sandy temper).  
 8 mm thick firing core - 5YR 7/3 (pink) <sup>mostly white, Zandank, gray, red</sup>  
 surface 5YR 6/10; both undulating surfaces (as vs. strictly flat), one ~~rough~~ rough to the touch, the other ~~smooth~~ broad side + the two narrow sides smoothed, and 5 gouges (longitudinal scoring) on the broad smooth side (each .5-1.4 cm long)  
 junctions of sides/edges are sharp angles (approximating 90° each) so overall effect is slightly convex rectangle in cross-section
