PSB106 Q/2-10	<p>fragment is in a triangular shape (acute triangle) 2 of the edges - the ones opposite one another are broken edges and reveal the firing core - which is a medium gray and occupies about 2/3 of the fragment body. What appears to be the underside surface is somewhat darker than the opposite parallel surface - and it is slightly convex. The shortest side of the triangle is smooth, rounded and finished. Throughout the fragment there are white and black specks. All of the breaks are fairly well worn as is the rest of the surface of the fragment.</p> <p>length of shortest side - 3.8 cm  length from tip of triangle to base - 5.2 cm.  thickness - .8 cm  color . 5YR 6/6 - reddish yellow</p>	36
