This fragment is similar to 114c/10-1 but is not probably from the same ~~piece~~: The spikes are larger though touching each other in a line of at least two. There is also a firing core.

Paste is fine with tiny inclusions, white. Surfaces are smooth and so are spikes. The spikes are pinched and applied, not very carefully.

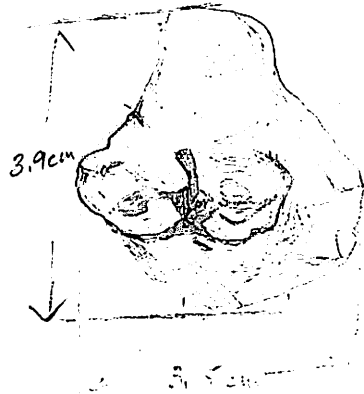
