SUBSTANCE: cerium

OBJECT: candles

Fragment of multi-chambered candle, principal chamber, with 3 vented ridges which suggest a thin

applied chamber applied on the sides ("pink") medium coarse sand-temper paste (7.5 YR 7/4) mixed with light fine claying on exterior and some burning

(part fine) on lower 1/2 of interior of the broken chambers (burning on interior chamber)

1 venting cone on main chamber an additional applique on main chamber exterior

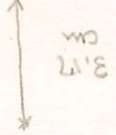
(see sketch re: all the above appliques and hole)

base is flat to slightly concave angle break of base is rounded but ca. 90°

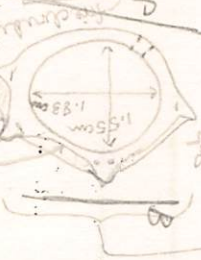
0.16 cm at top 0.39 cm of base 3 small thicknesses

hole is 0.34 x 1.18 cm, depth .84 cm

at edges indicated re. fire formation
