A coarse paste with small sandy inclusions \Rightarrow max size .8 mm in size. There is no firing core. There is one side that is burned from the ~~inside out or outside~~ scored side out creating 2 different colors in the piece which divides practically in half. Using the ever popular Munsell color chart the unburnt side appears to be 2.5 YR 4/6 also known as red. On one side the surface is smooth and the other is scored in a cross-hatch pattern. The rectangles created are 1.6 cm by 1 cm on average. The incisions are about 2 mm wide and very shallow. The burnt side according to Munsell is 5YR 3/1 or dark reddish brown
