P8B 325 B / 4  Cat 30	<p>rectangular shape - one surface has indentations small lines carved into clay. The lines are in a row. Lines run parallel to broken edges of handle This side of the fragment is rather rough and sandpaperlike - The opposite parallel plane is much smoother - grainy appearance to surface almost resembling brush strokes. Two of the 4 edges are broken - the 2 are parallel and are relatively well worn breaks and fairly straight. the other 2 edges run perpendicular to broken edges and are smooth and rounded.</p> <p>width - 3.3 (distance between smooth rounded edges.) length - 3.1 (distance between broken edges.) thickness - 1.2.</p> <p>Color - 5YR 6/6</p> <p>no visible firing core</p>	36
