This is a fragment of the base + part of the wall of a single chambered 3 legged (tripod) candeliers. It is very roughly, poorly made with a crude paste including small pebbles. The exterior is very rough, poorly smoothed if at all. The feet are ill formed + uneven pulled out from the bottom. The chamber bottom is rounded like it was formed by poking w/ a finger or other blunt implement
