There are two pieces to this fragment. The fragment exists on 2 planes. It seems to be the side of a censor & the ~~top~~ bottom ~~area~~ is attached as well. On the rounded edge leading to the other plane are indentations that are D shaped - leaflike, fern leaves. ~~On~~ The side surface is rounded. The other connecting surface is flat. This flattened surface has a foot at one end - it has been broken close to the base. At the opposite end on the rounded edge that connects the different surface there is a very large chip. Directly below this on the rounded surface is a hole to go directly through ceramic. Has smooth rounded edges. Below hole - which is formed by joining 2 pieces together - is the lip of the censor which is direct ~~upward~~ at. Only 5.4cm. This is still in fact.
