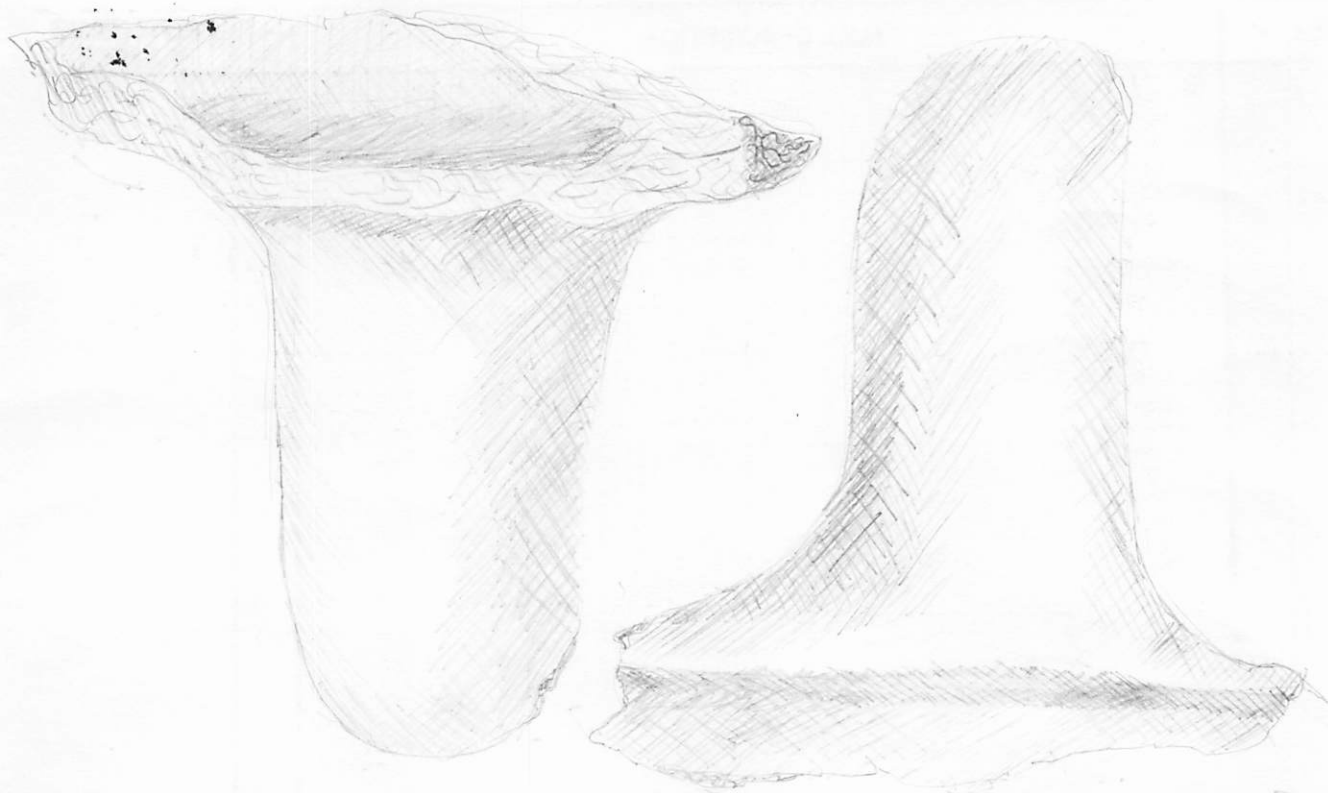

This censor prong is made of a fine paste. There is no firing core ~~• no inclusions~~. There are some very tiny (can't see without glasses) white inclusions; smaller than the average grain of sand. Colors range from 5YR 5/6 also known as yellowish red at a broken off piece to 5YR 3/1, a very dark gray. This too is one piece of which bashful eyes should beware; for it too appears ~~to~~ to resemble unmentionable male anatomy. IT stems from what appears to be a piece of base. There is no slip or paint on this piece
