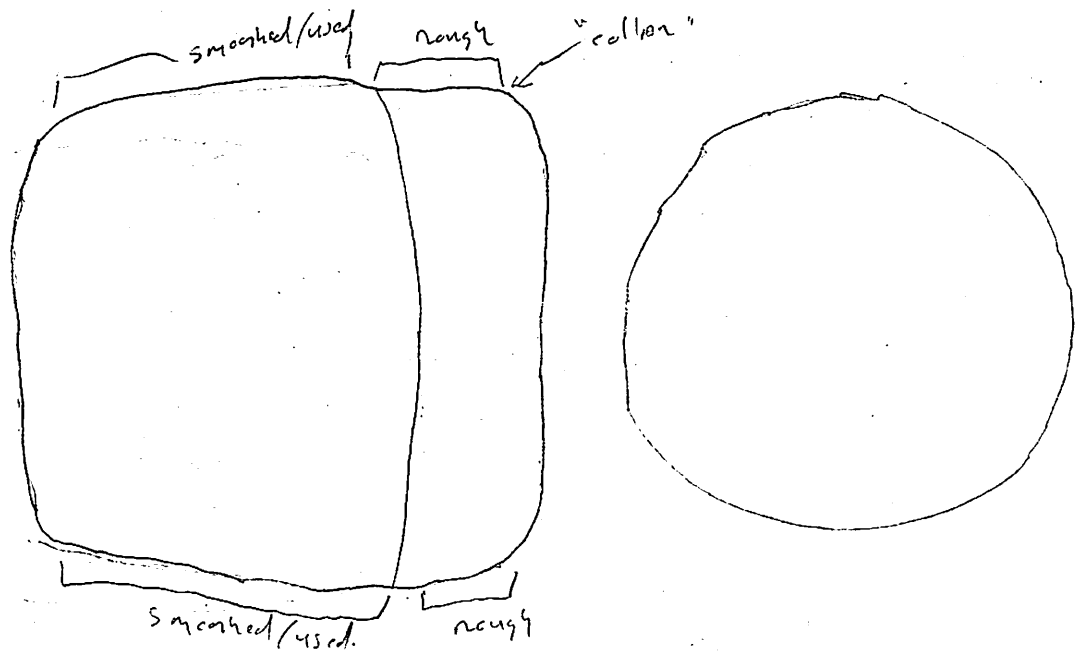

110/7-1	<p>Gray, vesicular basalt mano, very short, ca. 6.5cm long by 6.4cm thick (maximum). Despite its small size the piece seems to be complete. 2 faces are on opposite sides of the piece are smoothed from use while the rest remains rough. Both ends are rough but not, apparently, broken. Note, on one end, there is an area, ca. 1.8cm. wide which is rough, the smoothed surfaces stop here. This roughened area forms a collar around the piece: was this piece in the process of manufacture when it was broken and, subsequently, used? Circular cross-section.</p>	#1	D88-1-
